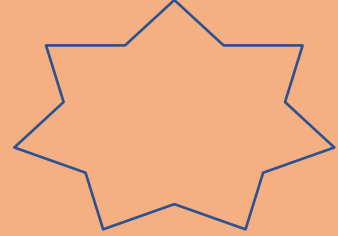
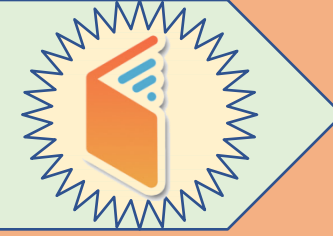

1. EXCRUCIATE (VERB): agonize: (कष्ट पहुंचाना)

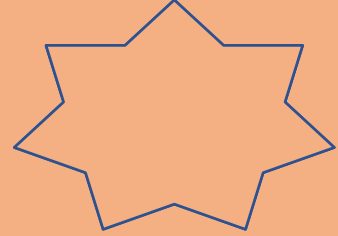
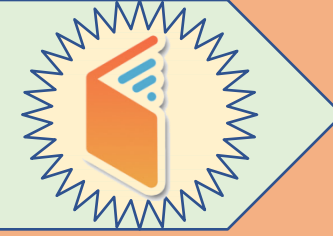
Synonyms: anguish, bother

Trick – इस screw को seat पर लगाने से बैठने वाले को कष्ट होगा।



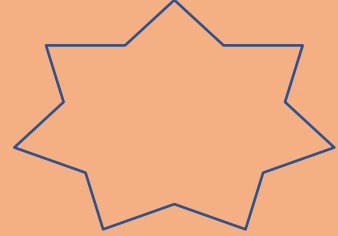
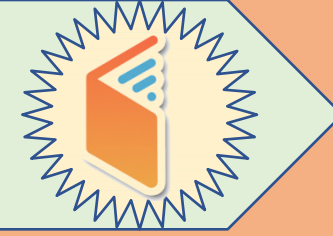
2. FOIBLE (NOUN): (चरित्र की दुर्बलता): shortcoming

3. HUBBUB (NOUN): (शोरगुल): uproar

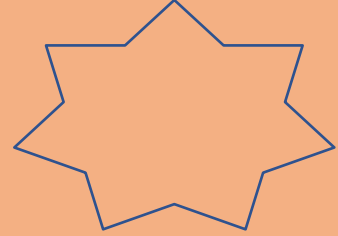
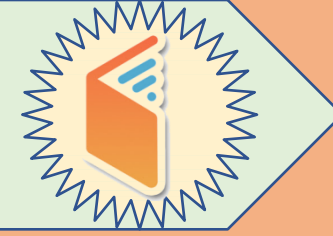
Synonyms: clamour, fuss

Hubbub ही होता है।**



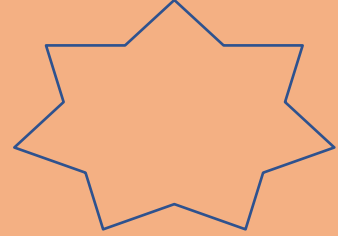
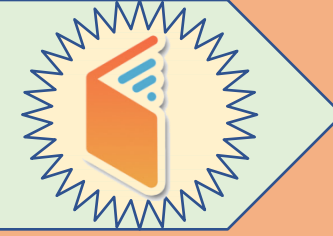
4. PARRY (VERB): avoid: (टालना)

Alisah parried the danger somehow.



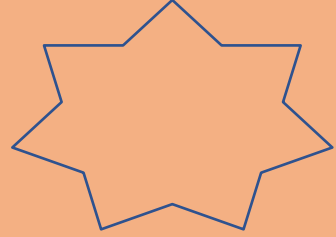
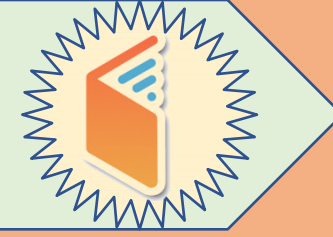
5. REVELRY (NOUN): merrymaking: (मद्यपान का उत्सव)

Antonyms: sadness, mourning

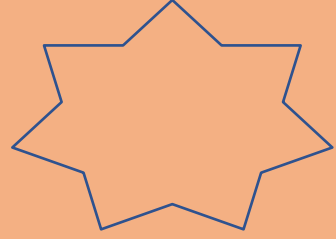
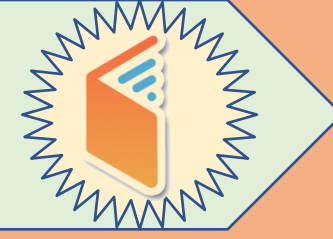

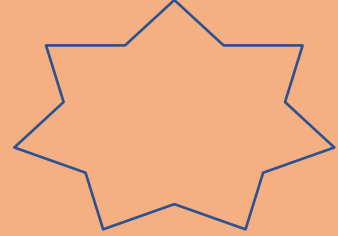
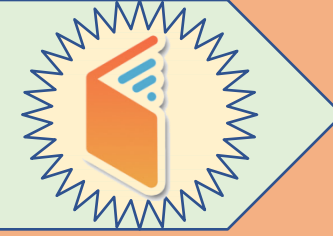
7. Scribble - Write hurriedly or carelessly in regard to hand writing. घसीटना, घसीट कर लिखने वाला, अस्पष्ट लेख

For example: I started to say something about the deal, but Mr Hamilton said, "Not now, my boy. We never talk turkey at the dinner table.

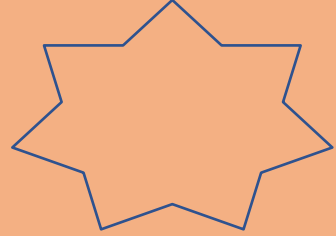
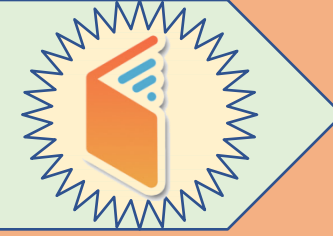

They usually base their new designs on the latest market research.



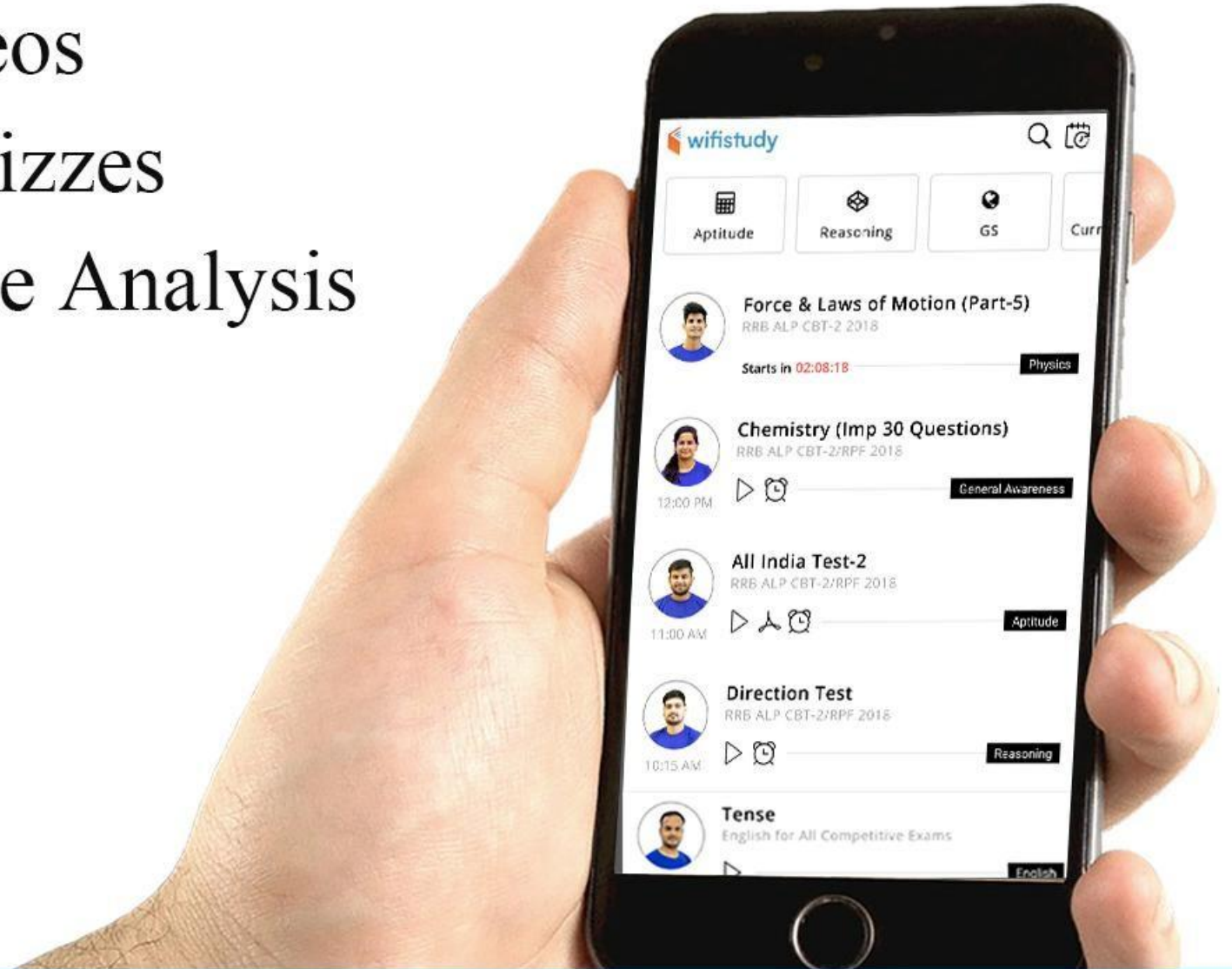
